Purchase of Exclusive Right Of Burial in St. Mary's Ditchingham Cemetery	
Reserved Plots – For Single or Double Depth Burials The Exclusive Right of Burial Grant (ERB) – This grant is for a period of 100 years. When a plot is purchased, it refers to acquiring the exclusive right to the grave space, not the purchase of the land itself. All grave owners have a legal right to be buried in the grave, and the exclusive right also means that the owner(s) control who can be buried in the plot. Interment fees apply to all burials and ashes interments taking place at the cemetery, whether Exclusive Rights of Burial have been purchased or not.	£425

*Burial or Burial of Cremated Ashes in an Existing Grave

If an Exclusive Right of Burial document confirming the purchase of a double depth grave is not available, the person organising the funeral must sign and submit a declaration issued by Ditchingham Parish Council stating that they have authorisation to permit a burial in the existing grave.

**Memorials

Proposals for the erection of a memorial together with a drawing showing the design and intended inscription must be submitted to the Parish Clerk for approval. The decision of the Clerk is final.
